

Invitation for proposals to offer new courses for AcSIR(EoS)M.Tech & PhD Students

Scientists of CSIR-SERC have recently shown some interest in designing new (elective) courses for M.Tech and PhD. In order to facilitate this, following guidelines are formulated with the approval of Director.

- i. The scientist wishing to propose a new course has to browse through the web site (<http://eos.acsir.res.in>) to know about the courses already approved by the senate.
- ii. The scientist should ensure that there is no duplication or overlap with the existing courses and can upload the new course in the stipulated format through the online submission to the EoS web site. The format essentially consists of the basic aim of the course, LTPC details, details of the syllabus and the number of hours required for each topic in the syllabus, prerequisites to take the course and also the reference material.
- iii. The new courses should be relevant to the current ongoing M.Tech and PhD program on Engineering of Structures
- iv. A committee consisting of two external experts will scrutinize the syllabus twice in a year and the courses cleared by the committee will be submitted to AcSIR for obtaining the approval.
- v. Once approved, the course syllabus will be placed on the web site and the students are free to opt for the course during their M.Tech or PhD.
